Despite this massive workload, Arnaud's boundless energy and infectious smile continue to shine through !




### **Introducing: Medgee Lebrasse - Cast Member**

Marie France is also another "graduate" from the "Weird Entertainers" group with her participation with a few of their plays.




# **Introducing: Dominique Finette - Cast Member**

She loves spending quality time with her grandsons and is delighted to renew her love affair with theatre by joining the cast of AYO!9M2.




### **Introducing: Gina Tranquille - Cast Member**
